Be rested,

Be prepared and ready for the day.

Be On Time: Showing up late or having a lazy attitude toward the things of God will not be tolerated.

Time surfing the internet, texting, receiving or making phone calls need to be done before or after office hours or during lunch.

(In case of emergency, phone calls will obviously be allowed)

With Staff and Team Members, you are expected to:

Treat members of the staff and team with the same respect that you would yourself want in return.

Strife will not be tolerated.

If you have a disagreement with a team or staff member, you are expected to follow Matthew 18: (The biblical standard)

Have and maintain an excellent attitude and have a willingness to not only get things done, but do them well.

Work diligently, passionately, and with the heart of a servant.

Relationships outside of RTAL

The Bible says that bad company corrupts good character. As an intern and Christ follower standards for close relationships should be biblical.

To Be on time for prayer and staff meetings, ready to take part and have an active role in those meetings.

For Services:

You are expected to arrive 1 hour before each service (your responsibilities will vary according to need, but there is always work to be done)

You are a model. Your life should reveal a zealotness for the Lord, passion, hunger, etc.

The house of God should be treated with utmost respect. We as leaders need to be an example as to how to treat God's house.

The disciplinary code will be as follows:

If you are approached by an intern director for violating the standards that we have put in place, discipline will be enforced the following way:

1) First time, you will receive a warning with an explanation of what the problem is and how to make different choices.

2) Second time you will have a meeting with Pastor Mike and whoever else may be involved in the training process.

3) Third time you will have 1 week suspension without your weekly stipend

4) Fourth time you will be dismissed from the program.

We are looking forward to working with you. Understand that standards must be put in place and what is expected of you as an intern must be established so that you are fully aware of the program you are entering into.
